### **Bishop's Wife - Matte Ivie Harrison -**

Inspired by a chilling true crime and written by a practicing Mormon, a fascinating look at the lives of modern Mormons as well as a grim and cunningly twisted mystery.

**The Children Act - Ian McEwan** - a 17 year old boy, is refusing for religious reasons the medical treatment that could save his life, and his devout parents echo his wishes. Time is running out. Should the secular court overrule sincerely expressed faith?

**Consider the Lillies - Ian Smith -** the thoughts and memories of an old woman who has lived all her life within the narrow confines of her Scottish Highlands community.
