**The Absolutist - John Boyne**- a masterfully told tale of passion, jealousy, heroism and betrayal set in the gruesome trenches of World War I.

**Black Swan Green – David Mitchell**- a coming of age story with all the angst, nostalgia, humor and heartbreak of adolescence

**Clever Girl - Tessa Hadley**- indelible story of one woman's life, unfolded in a series of beautifully sculpted episodes that illuminate an era, moving from the 1960s to today,

**Deep Blue Good-bye - John D MacDonald**- Travis McGee the self-described beach bum detective only works when his cash runs out, and his rule is simple: He'll help you find whatever was taken from you, as long as he can keep half.

**The Lightkeepers - Abby Geni**-an isolated environment, a limited group of characters who may or may not be trustworthy, a death that may or may not have been accidental
