You may have seen the scaffolding around our beautiful, historic building this summer and fall. We are pleased to report that our stone building has been completely repointed - a regular maintenance operation where failing mortar between each exterior stone is chipped away and replaced. Our project is a complete success, and was particularly intricate and costly, but necessary work. The project costs exceed \$400,000. Much of the expense will be paid for through two substantial grants, funding from our Building Reserve account and our operating budget. Thanks to your generous support and our committed and creative staff, the Library is more appreciated and popular than ever before. Our programs and services are thriving and the NWPL continues to provide a welcoming location for all ages to meet, share, and connect.

The Norman Williams Public Library, whose services are available to all at no charge, is not a fully-funded municipal library. Each year, nearly two-thirds of the NWPL's operating budget must come from fundraising. Please help us maintain our services with your donation today.

- Nearly 74,000 people came through our doors, including more than 9,000 last month alone and it is likely our librarians spoke with each and every one of them!
- 52,500 books were checked out
- 1,400 children and caregivers visited preschool story time
- 3,500 children attended after-school programs
- Nearly 1,500 books were added to our collections
