Trespasses by **Louis Kennedy** - Set in Northern Ireland during the Troubles, a shattering story of a young woman caught between allegiance to community and a dangerous passion.



Time and Again by **Jack Finney** - An artist is recruited to join a government operation exploring the possibility of time travel.



Time of the Child by Niall Williams - The lives of a small-town doctor and his daughter are turned upside down when a baby is left in their care.



The Women by **Kristin Hannah** - Idealistic Frankie joins the Army Nurse Corp and is sent to Vietnam where she is overwhelmed by the chaos and destruction of the war, but the real battle lies in coming home to a changed and divided America.

Fierce Attachments by Vivian Gornick - In her memoir, Gornick tells the story of her lifelong battle with her Mother for independence.








